New Initiative

We have a new initiative this year called "Seniors for Seniors" Program. Did you know the average life expectancy for an indoor cat is 15 years or that it is not uncommon for them to live from 18-20 years? A cat is considered a "senior" at the wee age of 9 or 10, which is barely midlife for them. Too often, these fur angels are overlooked as we get distracted by the all too cute (and very busy) little ones. It has also been shown that companion animals are a positive part of seniors lives, however often as we age we become concerned that we just can't keep up with the antics of a kitten. With that thought in mind, we at Serenity Place Rescue, have developed our "Senior for Seniors" program with reduced adoption fees for anyone 62 or older that wishes to adopt one of these angels. 
